#### By Bus

Via George's Street: 9, 14, 15, 15A, 15B, 16, 65, 68, 83, 122, 140.

Via Dame Street: 13, 27, 40, 49, 54A, 56A, 77A, 123, 150, 151, 747.

#### By Tram

The closest Luas stops are St Stephen's Green on the Green Line and Jervis on the Red Line.

#### Bv Car

Please note that there is no visitor parking available on site. The nearest public car parks are Q-Park Christchurch car park and Park Rite Drury Street.

#### By Foot

Dublin Castle can be accessed on foot via Palace St and Corke Hill gates from Dame St, or via Ship Street gate.


